- (1) Will submit Form 1024 which will meet 501(c) (19) compliance. Still working with Rob Shafer on 501(c) (3) status.

 - (1) Will work with attorney to set up NGA-NE Foundation once 501(c) (3) compliant.
- d. Discussion on current CD: CB CD which matured in November 2013. Decision was made to stay where it lays.
