Some highlights of the conference include: forecasting 40% military budget cut next year; theme of equipping the force has shifted to that of force structure; Jon Fago elected Director (Air) and Vicki Kramer elected as Company Grade Representative for Area V.

## 5. Treasury Report

a. Update: Total expenses budgeted FY14 (1 July to 30 June) \$91,770: FY to date-\$19,810.24; Projected by end of FY-\$91,770 (see attached income and expense report).
