Tournament Rules

1. **ORGANIZATION:** This shall be known as the NEBRASKA NATIONAL GUARD BOWLING TOURNAMENT (USBC Moral Support Sanction), organized for the purpose of conducting bowling activities to determine team and individual champions. It shall, at all times, foster and maintain the spirit of good sportsmanship among National Guard employees and retirees and their families.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to: (a) Current and retired members of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). (b) Current and retired Air Force Advisors of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). (c) Current and retired employees (state and federal) of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). Eligible USBC members will be automatically extended award recognition. Eligible nonmembers may qualify for USBC award recognition by purchasing an USBC affiliate membership before participation. USBC rule 301 does apply.
3. **ENTRY:** All teams must consist of five bowlers. Bowlers entered in doubles must also enter singles and vice versa. Doubles will be scheduled to follow singles automatically. Team and doubles line up must be arranged on entry form. No rearranging of line up after submission of entry form is allowed. *NOTE: State/Unit Coordinator must validate eligibility, proper spelling of first name, middle initial and last name and averages of participants. State/Unit Coordinator will consolidate and submit entries for that state/unit*
4. **SUBSTITUTES AND MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** If in any event a duly scheduled entrant is unable to bowl, the Captain shall have the right to substitute a bowler, provided the substitute has not already entered in that particular event. All substitutes must be identified at least two (2) hours before the scheduled time of bowling. An individual may bowl in each event one time, unless exception is granted by Tournament Director. Exceptions will be considered only in the event of an unforeseen need. Multiple participation can only be utilized in the Doubles and Team events if no substitute is available. First appearance in an event will count towards their ALL EVENTS score. Individuals will not be allowed to cash more than once in any one event (USBC rule 315).
5. **AVERAGES:**
 - a) Entrants will use their highest previous season's USBC Sanctioned League Average (Winter or Summer) as recorded in their Local Association records and which shall be certified by the team captain. A minimum of 21 games must have been bowled to establish an average; when the previous season's average is used, and at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 15 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used.
 - b) If no previous season USBC winter or summer season average: use the highest current USBC winter season average as of January 1 of the tournament year based on 21 or more games.
 - c) If no average last season or Jan 1 average: use highest recorded USBC, YABA Youth or Collegiate Division Sanctioned current average, based on 21 or more games at the time of close of entries;
 - d) If no average last season, no Jan 1 average, and no current average: if an entrant has not bowled 21 games on entry date, but will have 21 games on bowling date, he or she shall report their current average at the Tournament office before bowling in each event.
 - e) Bowlers without an established, sanctioned average per any above, may:
 - 1) submit an average of 21 games or more on a non-sanctioned league, in accordance with the precedence set above for a sanctioned average. The average must be verified by the league secretary.
 - 2) use their last established average for the Air National Guard tournament within the past three tournaments (of nine games or more) - bowlers must submit tournament and actual scores bowled with entry form;
 - f) If no previous sanctioned or unsanctioned average, or Jan 1 average, or current average, nor previous tournament average, the average of all bowled events (only complete series shall apply) during the tournament will be used (not less than a complete series of three games in an one event must be bowled to qualify for this rule).
Bowlers who do not meet any of the requirements above will be entered with a 210 average (refer to USBC rule 319b). Any bowler who has ONLY A USBC SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGE must submit and use his/her adjusted Sport Bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. The scale can be found on bowl.com or USBC Playing Rules.
The bowler is responsible for the average used on the score sheet. If an entrant's average is understated on the score sheet, both the entrant and the team collectively shall forfeit any and all right to claim any trophy or prize in the Tournament unless correction is made before beginning competition bowling. If an entrant's average is overstated on the score sheet, correction must be made before beginning competition bowling, or the entrant must use average as stated. No adjustments will be made after the entrant has bowled.
6. **HANDICAP:** The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis. Each bowler shall receive a handicap of eighty (80) percent of the difference between his or her average and two hundred ten pins (210) in each event entered.
7. **PREVIOUS PRIZE WINNERS:** USBC rule 319e does not apply
8. **PRIZES:** (a) All fees must accompany entry form; (b) Prizes will be paid with a ratio of at least 1:10, except for ALL EVENTS, which will be based upon a ratio of at least 1:20. (c) 100% prize fees will be awarded.
9. **FEES:** (a) Bowling Lineage \$9.75 per event; (b) Prize \$4.00 per single event; -\$9.25 per double event; \$27.00 per team event; (c) Other Expenses \$1.25 per event; (e) All Events \$1.00 (optional). All fees must accompany the entry form and be received prior to closing date of entries.

10. **ALL EVENTS:** Entry in ALL EVENTS is optional. To qualify, a bowler must enter Team, Doubles, and Singles. ALL EVENTS will be the culmination of the three handicap series.
11. **ADDITIONAL RULES:** Tournament rules and guidelines not stated herein will defer to USBC Tournament rules. Tournament Director has final ruling decision on all disputes, complaints, or protests involving USBC or tournament rules. Unless an ap peal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.

Tournament Rules

CLOSING DATE: Entries and fees must be received by 10 April 2009

- ORGANIZATION:** This shall be known as the Annual Air National Guard Tournament is a game of American Tenpins This tournament a USBC Moral Support Sanction function and is organized for the purpose of conducting bowling activities to determine team and individual champions. It shall, at all times, foster and maintain the spirit of good sportsmanship among Air National Guard employees and retirees and their families. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis. Each bowler shall receive a handicap of (80) percent of the difference between his or her average and two hundred and ten pins (210) in each event entered.
- ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to: (a) Current and past members of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). (b) Current and past Air Force Advisors of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). (c) Current and past employees (state and federal) of the Air National Guard, spouses, and immediate family members over 18 (parents, children, grandchildren, siblings only). Eligible USBC members will be automatically extended award recognition. Eligible nonmembers may qualify for USBC award recognition by purchasing an USBC affiliate membership before participation. USBC rule 301 does apply. **ENTRY:** All teams must consist of five bowlers. Bowlers entered in doubles must also enter singles and vice versa. Doubles will be scheduled to follow singles automatically. Team and doubles line up must be arranged on entry form. No rearranging of line up after submission of entry form is allowed. **NOTE: State/Unit Coordinator must validate eligibility, proper spelling of first name, middle initial and last name. State/Unit Coordinator will consolidate and submit entries for that state/unit** State/unit representatives are responsible for verifying averages of tournament participants from his/her state and shall sign the entry acknowledging this verification. Each bowler is responsible for reporting his/her correct eligible average in accordance with rules and by-laws.
- SUBSTITUTES AND MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** If in any event a duly scheduled entrant is unable to bowl, the Captain shall have the right to substitute a bowler, provided the substitute has not already entered in that particular event. All substitutes must be identified at least two (2) hours before the scheduled time of bowling. An individual may bowl in each event one time, unless exception is granted by Tournament Director. Exceptions will be considered only in the event of an unforeseen need. Multiple participation can only be utilized in the Doubles and Team events if no substitute is available. First appearance in an event will count towards their ALL EVENTS score. Individuals will not be allowed to cash more than one in any one event (USBC rule 315).

AVERAGES: USED:

- Entrants will use their highest previous season's USBC Sanctioned League Average (Winter or Summer) as recorded in their Local Association records and which shall be certified by the team captain. A minimum of 21 games must have been bowled to establish an average
- If no previous season USBC winter or summer season average: use the highest current USBC winter season average as of January 1, 2009 based on 21 or more games.
- If no average last season or Jan 1 average: use highest recorded USBC, YABA Youth or Collegiate Division Sanctioned current average, based on 21 or more games at the time of close of entries;
- If no average last season, Jan 1 average, or current average: if an entrant has not bowled 21 games on entry date, but will have 21 games on bowling date, he or she shall report their current average at the Tournament office before bowling in each event.
- Bowlers without an established, sanctioned average per 1, 2, 3, or 4 may:
 - submit an average of 21 games or more on a non-sanctioned league, in accordance with the precedence set above for a sanctioned average. The average must be verified by the league secretary
 - use their last established average for the Air National Guard tournament within the past three tournaments (of nine games or more) - bowlers must submit tournament and actual scores bowled with entry form;
- If no previous sanctioned or unsanctioned average, or Jan 1 2008 average, or current average, nor previous tournament average, the average of all bowled events (only complete series shall apply) during the tournament will be used (not less than a complete series of three games in one event must be bowled to qualify for this rule).
- Bowlers who do not meet any of the requirements of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6, will be entered with a 210 average (refer to USBC rule 362A #1 and #2).

The Tournament officials shall not be responsible for average errors by persons filling in entry blanks. If an entrant's average is understated on the score sheet, both the entrant and the team collectively shall forfeit any and all right to claim any trophy or prize in the Tournament unless correction is made before beginning competition bowling. If an entrant's average is overstated on the score sheet, correction must be made before beginning competition bowling, or the entrant must use average as stated. No adjustments will be made after the entrant has bowled. The bowler is responsible for the average used on the score sheet. No tournament prize winnings during the previous twelve months need be reported. USBC rules 319a and 319c apply. USBC rule 319e does not apply. Any bowler who has ONLY A USBC SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGE must submit and use his/her adjusted Sport Bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. The scale can be found on bowl.com or USBC Playing rules.

- HANDICAP:** Handicap will be based upon 80% of the difference of the entering average and 210.
- PRIZES:** (a) All fees must accompany entry form; (b) Prizes will be paid with a ratio of at least 1:10, except for ALL EVENTS, which will be based upon a ratio of at least 1:20. (c) 100% prize fees will be awarded.
- FEES:** (a) Bowling Lineage: \$6.00 per event; (b) Prize:\$8.00 per event; (c) contribution to ANG Bowling Museum:\$.25 per event; (d) Other Expenses:\$10.25 per event; (e) All Events \$3.00 (optional). All fees must accompany the entry form and be received prior to closing date of entries.
- ALL EVENTS:** Entry in ALL EVENTS is optional. To qualify, a bowler must enter Team, Doubles, and Singles. ALL EVENTS will be the culmination of the three handicap series.
- ADDITIONAL RULES:** Tournament rules and guidelines not stated herein will defer to USBC Tournament rules. Tournament Director has final ruling decision on all disputes, complaints, or protests involving USBC or tournament rules. Unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
