President's Report: Lt Col Johnson

Thank you for taking time to be here there's a lot going on within the NGANE.

1: LT Rowley and I attended NGEDA in Reno January 16-19 and have reserved 20 rooms and an executive suite at Circus Circus as the 45th pick this year. Next year at Detroit we've moved up to the 40th spot in the selection. 2: We've also joined in on a Hospitality night venue with 6 other states (TX, NM, AL, WA, GA, TN and nicknamed the Lucky 7) at El Jefe's Cantina. Last year in Columbus the other six states held their

hospitality night in the Sonesta (across the drive from the lobby if you attended). They raised \$25K last year to support the evening, and that is what the projected cost is again for this year but there will be better advertising opportunity for a couple of the major sponsors.

- 3: There's a Legislative social scheduled for tomorrow (8 February) at the Scottish Rite one of the bills LB52 is currently impacting members of the NENG as the state has hit the \$900K cap and will need to increase the cap for this year, bill set to raise the cap to \$1M.
- 4: I would like to entertain the creation of two new committees/groups, the first one would be Sponsorship Committee to focus on our sponsor relations. LTC Henrickson has made great strides to build out states sponsor pool but we need to be reaching out to them, thanking them for their support and asking if there's anything we can do to assist them. The other is a CGO Group. As we've focused on building out a CGO core and seeing how they enjoy each other company at the national NGAUS conference, it would be great to see them have some of their own social, mentorship, etc. events.

President Elect's Report: CPT Meyers

- 1: I visited with the current OCS group about NGANE and getting their memberships going following OCS graduation, they should start 1 APR, thank you Lt Rowley.
- 2: We are on the lookout for a social media lead, I think LT Nordhues is interested and will follow up.

Past President Elect's Report: COL Fineran

- 1: I will be there for the Legislative social to meet the legislators and their aids. If you attend be interested, ask them questions on processes and get their opinions, but remember to keep your opinions neutral. We can help them with gathering research and information to make better decisions on behalf on our soldiers and airman.
- 2: With regard to our Sponsorships we should look at targeted social opportunities, I and LTC Henrickson will look into some.
